

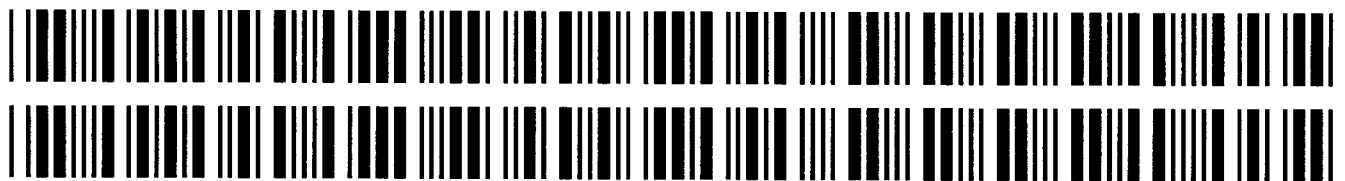

MEMORANDUM FOR 9/11 COMMISSION

SUBJECT: Request for additional items during Langley Visit

1. On 6 October 2003 during the commissions visit and discussion of the Search and Rescue events surrounding the 9/11 disaster you requested several follow pieces of information. The following information and explanations is provided in support of that request.

a. An operations plot (historical ELT data search) was requested from the United States Mission Control Center using the following parameters.

Date of request 9/11/01

Time of request 1200-1430Z (0800-1030 EST)

Center point - 40 38N 073 46W (JFK Airport) and 38 51N 077 02W (Reagan National Airport)

Radius of search - 50 NM

Frequency searched - 121.5, 243.0, 406.0

The results of those searches are attached as Tab 1 and 2. They show no ELT signal being heard by the satellites during the periods requested.

b. We have pulled the AFRCC incident log detailing the events surrounding the Payne Stewart incidents provided at Tab 3. We never dispatched forces but coordinated with SEADS who handled the intercept and escort.

c. A copy of the Pre 9/11/01 hijack checklist no longer exists. Our standard is to update all our checklists on an annual basis. We have attached the oldest copy we had, dated 12 Jul 02, at Tab 4

d. At the time of the 9/11 events the AFRCC used a Digital Audio Tape (DAT) machine to record all incoming and outgoing telephone calls. The DATs were held for approximately 30 days and then recorded over. During the latter part of 2002, the recording machine began to malfunction and destroy the tapes. The machine has since been replaced and the tapes no longer exist.

NOTE: A HIJACK IS A FEDERAL CRIME. THEREFORE THE FBI IS RESPONSIBLE FOR THE OVERALL HIJACK SITUATION. HOWEVER, THE AFRCC WILL ASSIST BY COORDINATING THE SEARCH AND/OR RESCUE RESULTING FROM THE HIJACKING. CONTROLLERS SHOULD BE ESPECIALLY CAUTIOUS TO AVOID PUTTING SRUS IN JEOPARDY.

1. RECEIVE INFORMATION AND INITIATE ACFT INCIDENT FORM (AFRCC FORM 3).

A. Complete the following:

- (1) Requester name
- (2) RCC position # and initials
- (3) DTGZ info received (DDHHMMZ MMM YY)
- (4) Acft Call sign
- (5) Type acft and description
- (6) Nature of emergency
- (7) Destination/pilot's intentions
- (8) DTGZ of ETA (DDHHMMZ MMM YY)
- (9) Last known position
- (10) DTGZ (DDHHMMZ MMM YY)
- (11) POB

B. Write "hijack" in bold red letters diagonally from top left across the form.

C. Find location using SARMaster.

2. BRIEF SHIFT SUPERVISOR, OBTAIN AN INCIDENT NUMBER, AND OPEN AN ELECTRONIC LOG.

3. NOTIFY:

A. NMCC and ACC battle staff, through the ACC command center (4-1555).

B. The AFRCC RC or RCC.

C. ACC public affairs (4-5007/5471).

4. SURVEY SAR UNITS IN THE AREA, BUT DO NOT ALERT THEM UNLESS SEVERITY INDICATES POSSIBLE CRASH; HOWEVER PRE-ALERTING SAR UNITS MAY BE ADVISABLE DEPENDING ON THE SITUATION.

NOTE: FOR EMERGENCY ASSISTANCE/INTERCEPT FOR AIRCRAFT IN DISTRESS SEE CBC 5A.

5. FOR CRASH, OVERDUE, OR RADIO/RADAR CONTACT LOST:

A. Brief shift supervisor.

B. Open mission (see CBCs 04A NTAP.doc and 16 MSN OPN.doc).

C. Update points of contact listed at step 3.

D. Check the flexfile, and notify the appropriate state SAR agency.

6. AFTER ISSUE IS RESOLVED:

A. Brief shift supervisor.
